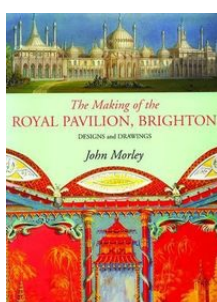


THE MAKING OF THE ROYAL PAVILION, BRIGHTON: DESIGN AND DRAWINGS
